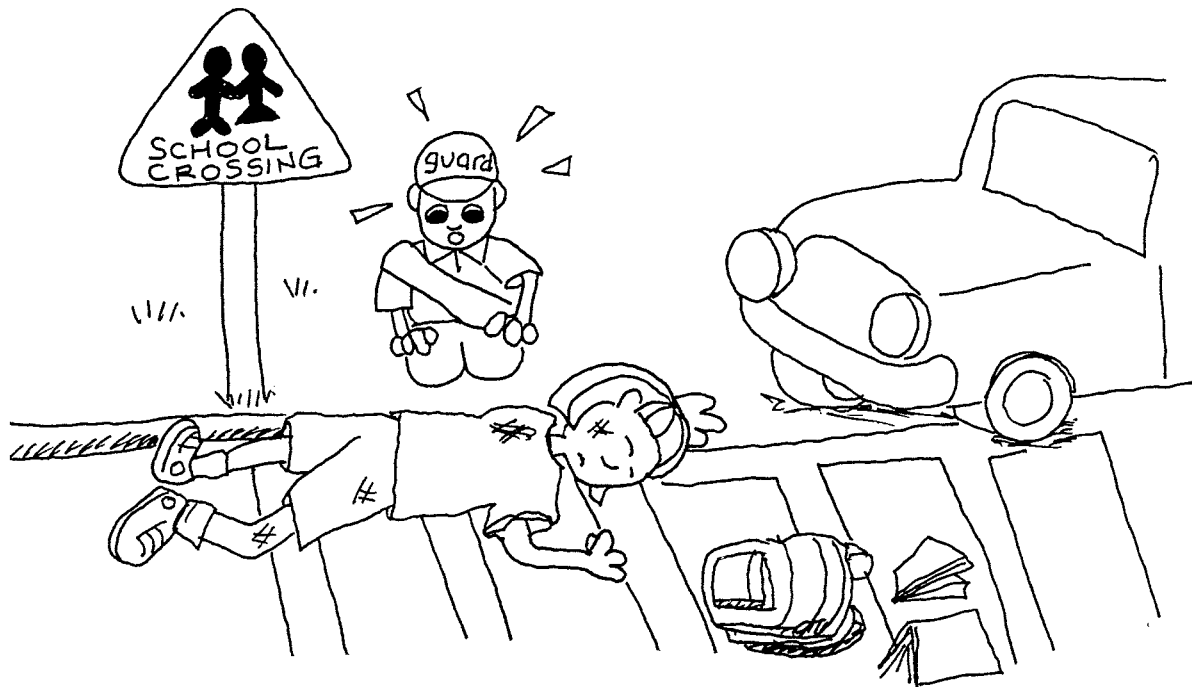

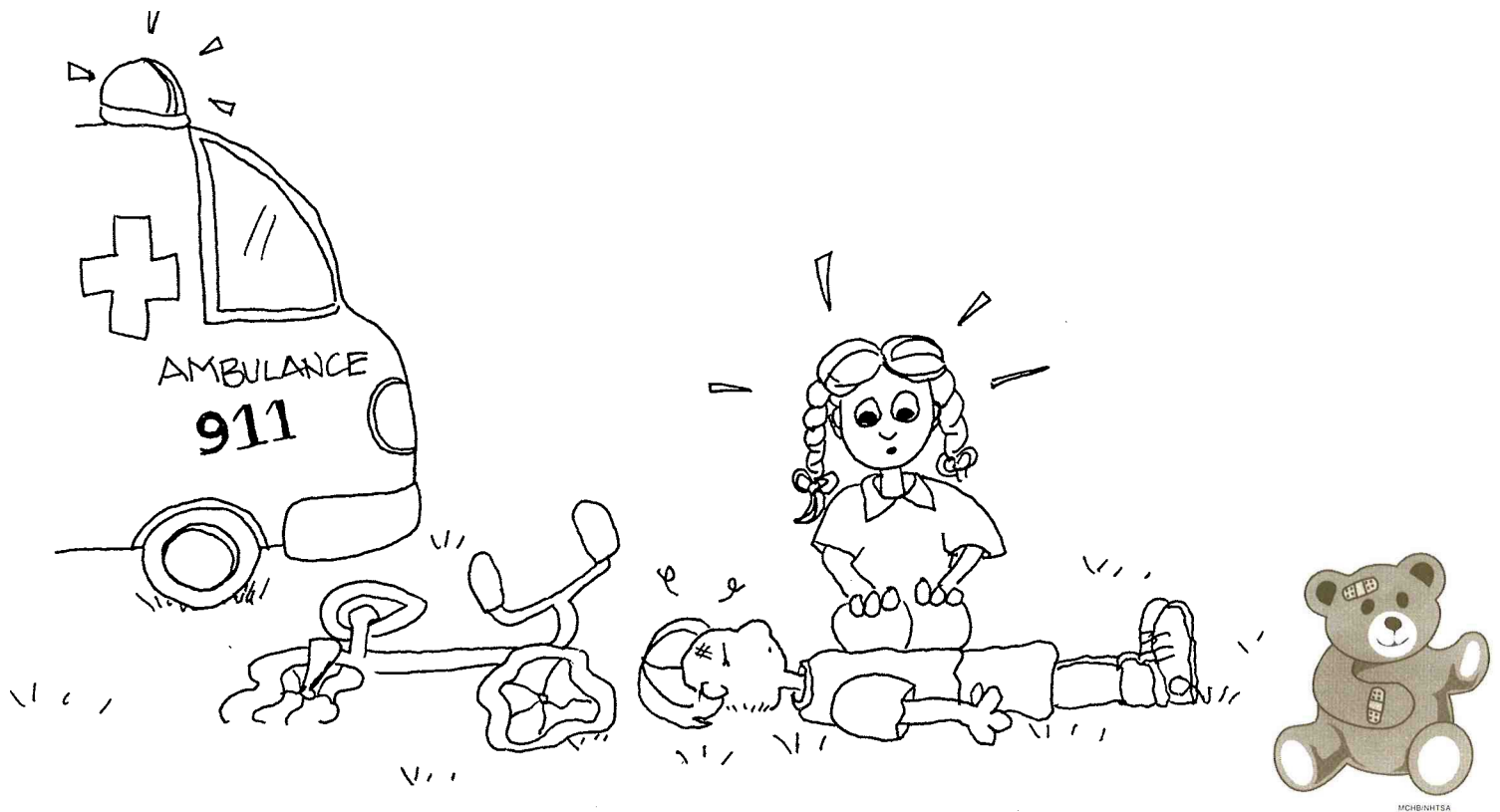
**It can be scary when

when you need help fast.**



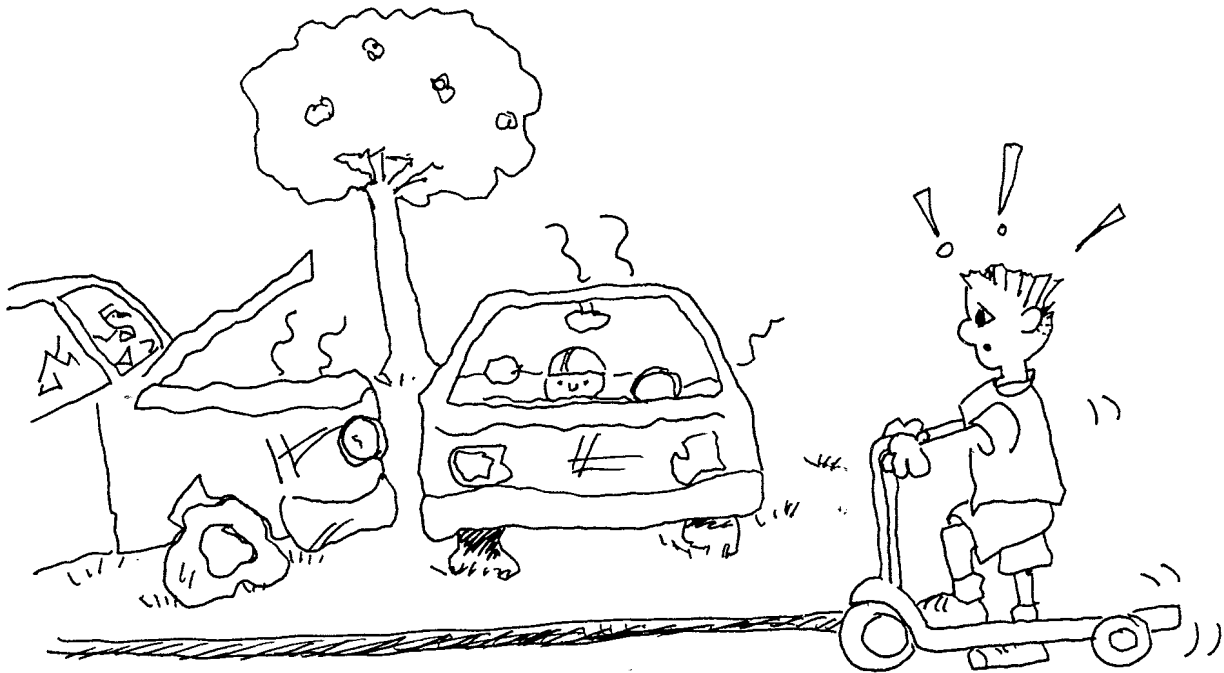
**If you see someone  
who is hurt, call 911.**



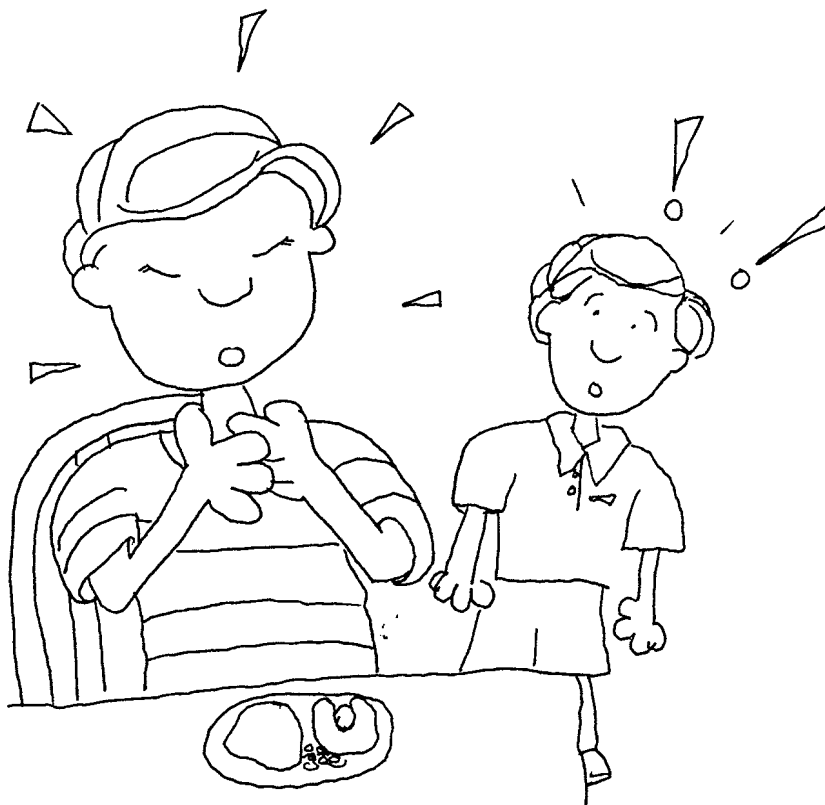
**If someone is in trouble  
and needs help, call 911.**



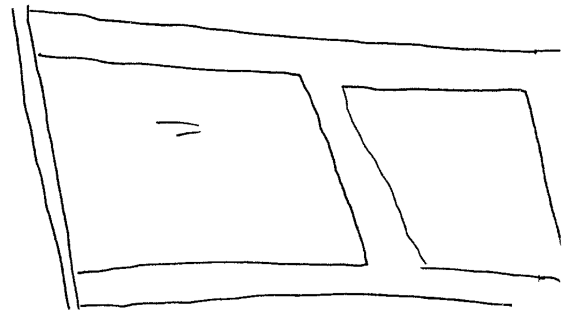
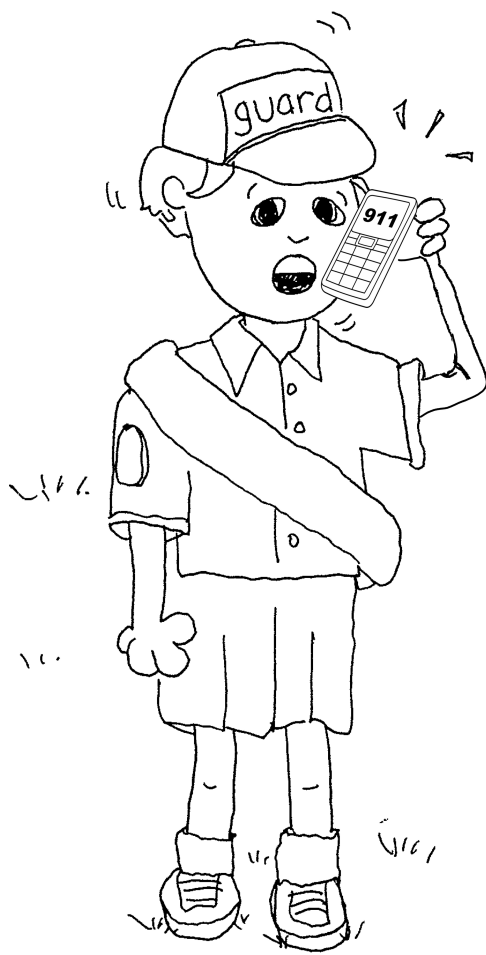
**If you see a car crash, call 911.**

After you call 911, you will be asked questions.

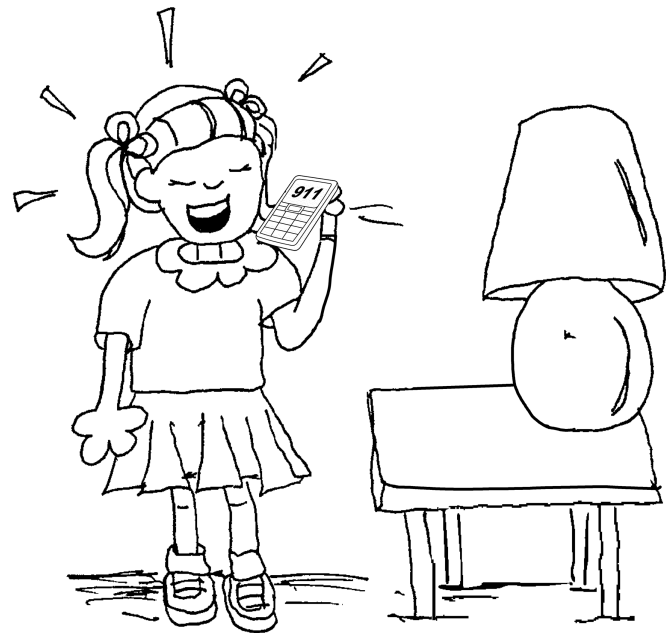
Pretend you are at home with an emergency and practice filling in the answers to the questions.
