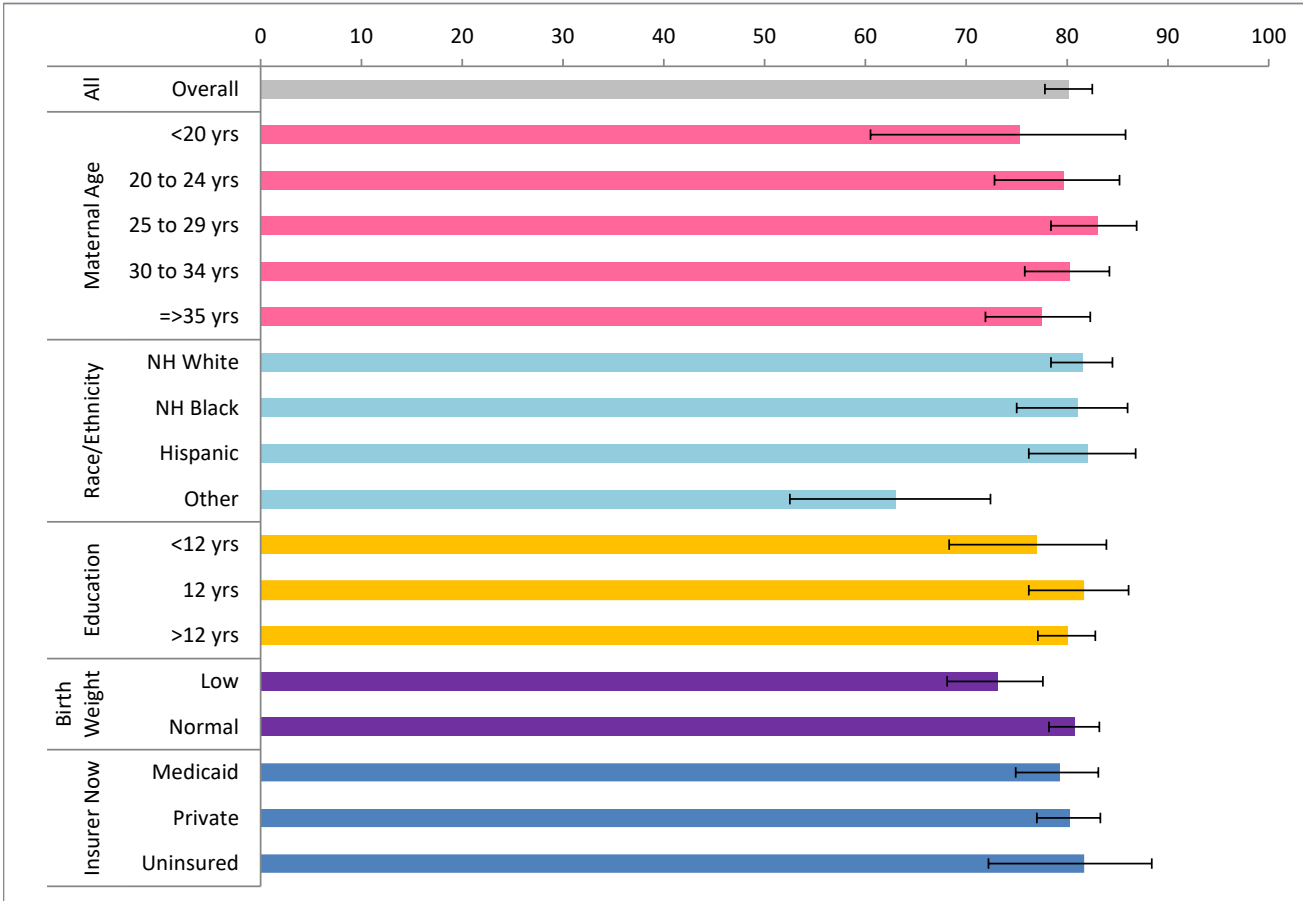


Birth Control Use After Delivery
