## Agenda Items

### **1. Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) Update**

- Illinois has been invited by the Association of Maternal and Child Health Programs (AMCHP) to participate in a Maternal and Child Environmental Health Collaborative Innovation and Improvement Network (CoIIN) to support and improve coordinated systems of care to address the needs of maternal, infant, and child populations that are at risk for or experience exposure to lead. In partnership with the IDPH Division of Environmental Health, the Division of Maternal, Child and Family Health Services will use this opportunity to work on policy and process for reducing the risk of lead exposure to newborns by screening at risk women during pregnancy. We have already asked Dr. Border and Dr. Locher to advise the committee. Work will begin with a kick-off webinar on 1/11/18. More to come.
- Introduced Catherine Adalakun, the new IDPH perinatal administrator.

### **2. Illinois Perinatal Quality Collaborative (ILPQC) Update**

- Ann Borders gave an update from the ILPQC:
  - o Covered updates from the October meeting.
  - o ILPQC has reached and are over the time to treatment goal with facilities. Wanted to be above 80% and are now at 84%.
  - o ILPQC is working on sustainability for time to treatment for 2018.
  - o Discussed hospitals use of note cards to help.
  - o The use of magnesium showed reduced preeclampsia
  - o Brought up to recommend 30/60/90 day plan if they do not meet 80% of women to receive the proper time to treatment

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- o Further discussion around sustaining time to treatment and how to possibly bring it into some type of policy.
- o Talked about the annual conference on December 19th

**3. Old Business**

- ILPQC/SQC Relationship
  - o ILPQC shares the data with the networks
- Standardized Mortality and Morbidity Review Update/Follow-Up
  - o The original review team from the SQC got shifted into the Levels of Care committees and formed from the Quality Improvement.
