



Plumbing Inspector/Champaign Region/Division of Environmental Health

The Illinois Department of Public Health, Office of Health Protection, has an opening for a Plumbing Inspector in the Champaign Regional Office. This individual independently performs professional plumbing inspections of private and commercial properties to assure that the plumbing is installed in compliance with laws and regulations to provide safe and sanitary conditions. This position also investigates complaints of unlicensed plumbing activities and associated plumbing code violations.

The successful candidate will demonstrate knowledge, skill and mental development equivalent to completion of four years of high school and will possess of a valid Illinois plumber's license with at least seven years of experience as a plumber. Candidates will be required to successfully pass the Department of Public Health's examination for certification as a Plumbing Inspector within six months of hire. Candidates must demonstrate extensive knowledge of the Illinois State Plumbing Code, working knowledge of the tools, equipment, materials, methods, and practices of the trade; working knowledge of hydraulics, pneumatics and mathematics; working knowledge of state laws as they relate to prevention and control of communication diseases caused by environmental factors.

Requirements for this position include excellent computer skills and work experience in Microsoft software products including, Word, Excel, Power-point, etc. is highly desirable; possession of a valid Illinois driver's license; ability to climb stairs or ladders, access crawl spaces, utility tunnels and other restricted access areas; ability to negotiate construction sites in a safe manner, including wearing site specific required personal protective equipment; and the ability to lift up to 50 lbs. Candidates must reside in either Champaign or Vermilion Counties.

The current salary range for this position is \$4,844 – \$7,124 per month
