



Public Service Administrator (PSA), Option 8E (Plumbing and Water Quality Program Manager)

The Illinois Department of Public Health, Office of Health Protection has an opening for a Public Service Administration, Option 8E (aka Plumbing and Water Quality Program Manager) within the Division of Environmental Health. The Plumbing Program Manager is responsible for planning, developing, organizing, directing and coordinating the activities of the Statewide Plumbing and Water Quality Program, which is responsible for administering the Illinois State Plumbing Licensing Law and Code and its application in engineered water supply and waste systems. The Plumbing and Water Quality Program Manager also reviews and approves engineering plans for water harvesting projects, oversees the Department's response to lead in drinking water and serves as a working supervisor. This position is based in Springfield, Illinois.

Requires an engineering degree from an ABET-accredited university or college. Requires three years of progressively responsible administrative experience in the environmental health or engineering field. Requires current Illinois license as a Professional Engineer. Prefers extensive knowledge of the state laws as they relate to prevention and control of communicable diseases caused by environmental factors (plumbing and potable water, private sewage, Water Well Construction Code, Water Well Pump Code and Food Service Sanitation Rules and Regulations). Requires coursework or demonstrated knowledge of fluid movement, hydrodynamics, mechanical systems and the Illinois Plumbing License Law, as well as applicable laws, rules and codes. Requires working knowledge of Microsoft Office products (Word, Excel, PowerPoint). Requires the ability to perform physical requirements of the position, minimally lifting 50 pounds, bending, crawling, climbing stairs and ladders and any other physical motions necessary to observe plumbing in place. Requires the ability to travel. Requires a valid Illinois driver's license.

The current salary range for this position is \$6,141 - \$9,472 per month
