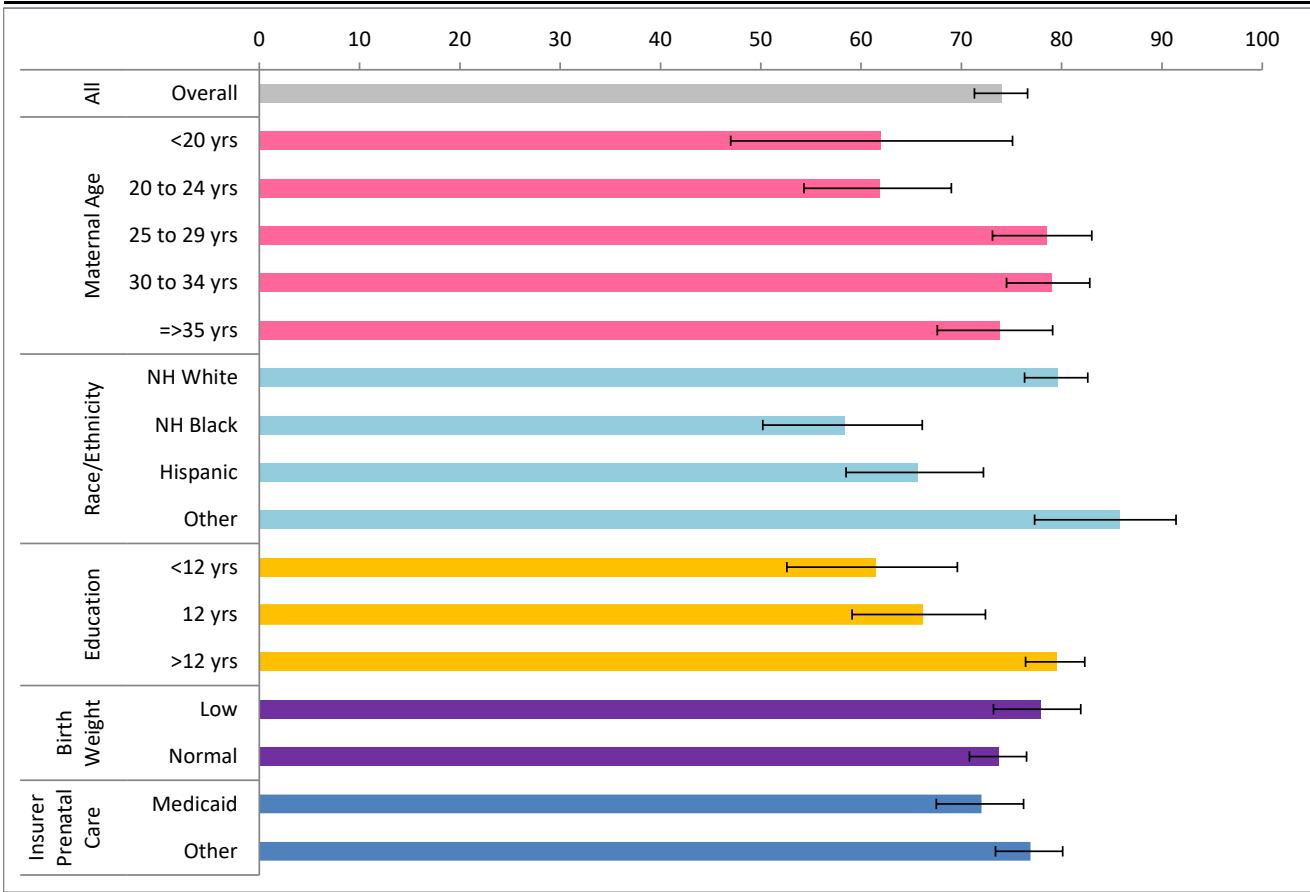


Prenatal Care
