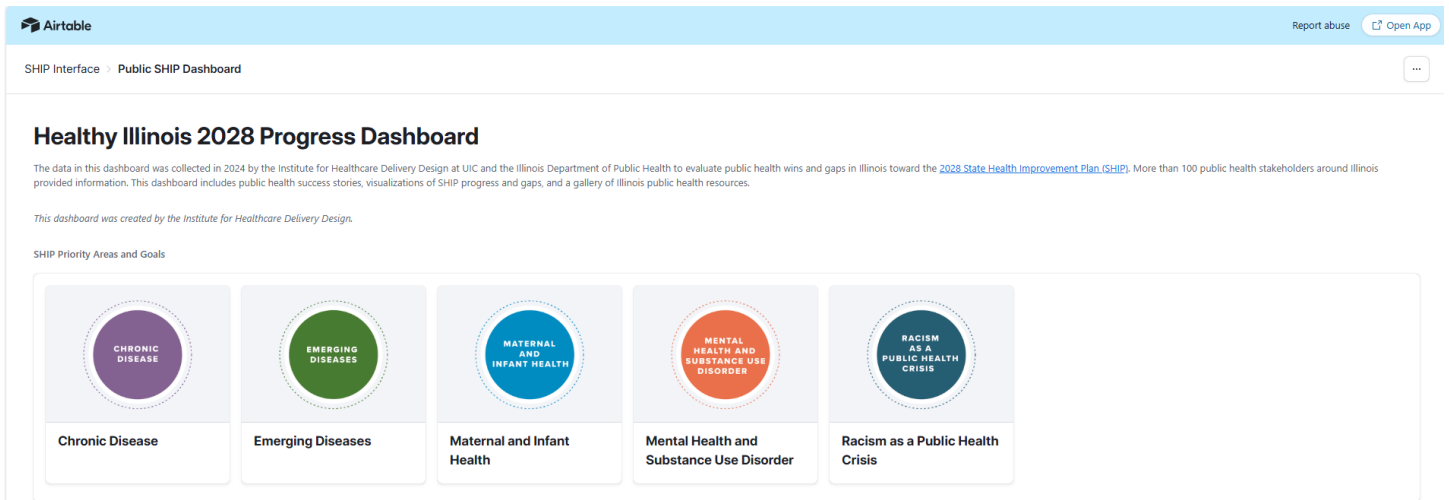

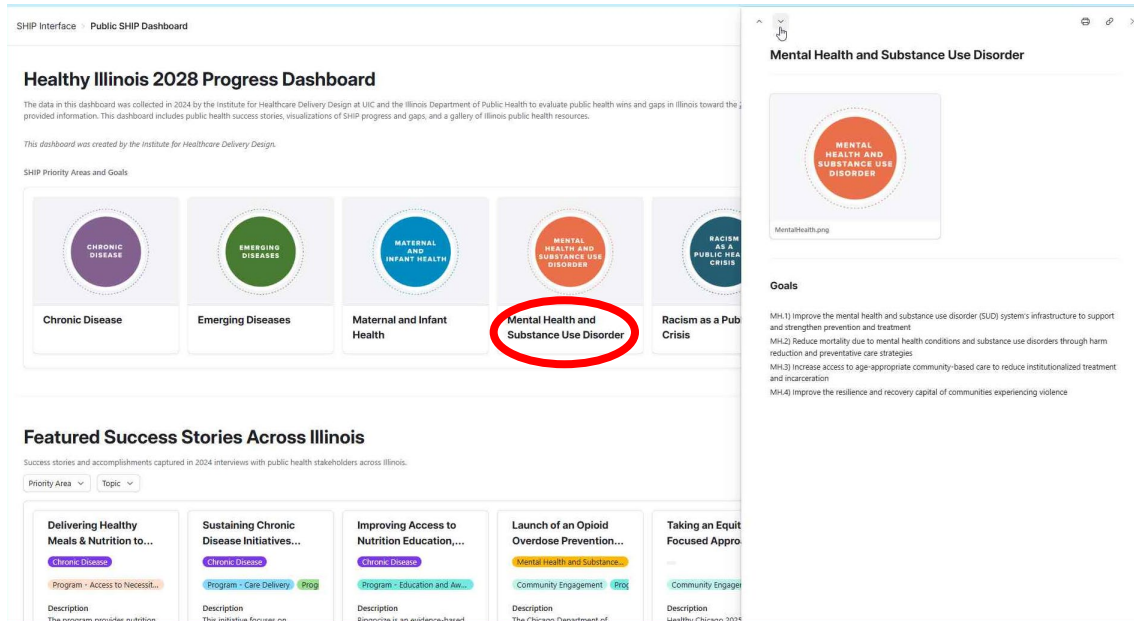

SHIP Priority Areas and Goals Section

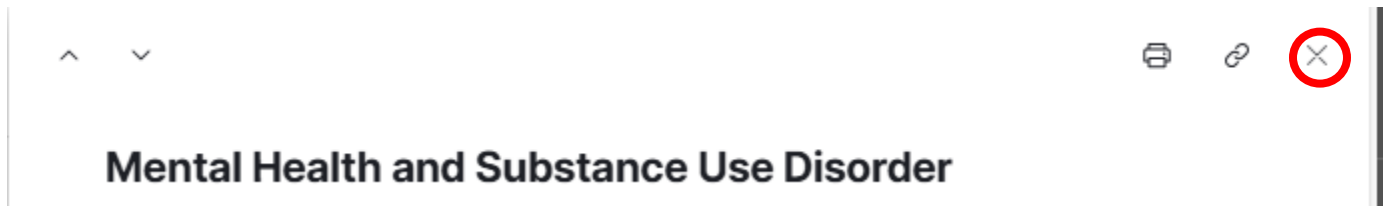
1. Across the top is a row of circles, representing the five priorities, that can be clicked on to show the goals of that priority.



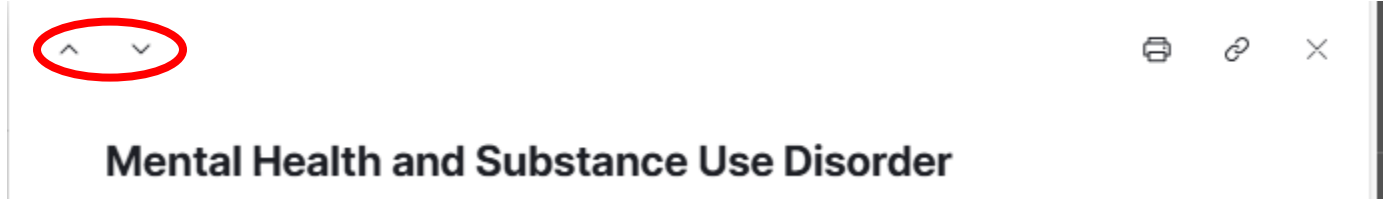
2. When the words below the priority circle are clicked (red circle), it opens a tab to the right side of the page.

Sustaining Chronic Disease Initiatives through Multi-Year CDC Grant

Success Story

Description

This initiative focuses on addressing diabetes and cardiovascular disease through a five-year grant from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The program emphasizes screening for social determinants of health and closing the loop on clinical-community linkages, as well as the expansion of self-management programs for diabetes and cardiovascular disease prevention and control. In the first year of the grant, baseline data was collected on various program efforts.

Organizations Involved

The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) received the grant from the CDC and funnels the funding downstream to state associations, federally qualified health centers, critical access hospitals, community pharmacies, and local health departments, who do work on the ground.

Interventions

The grant supports improvements in electronic health record systems, incorporates social determinants of health screenings, and facilitates community-clinical linkages. It also funds hospitals to conduct Diabetes Prevention Programs (DPP) and Diabetes Self-Management Education and Support (DSMES) programs, and Self-Measured Blood Pressure (SMBP) programs.

Outcomes and Metrics

Baseline data on referrals and access to services have been collected. This data will serve as a baseline for future progress measurement.

Geography and Populations Served

The program serves populations across Illinois, with specific focus areas determined by the locations of participating hospitals and healthcare providers.

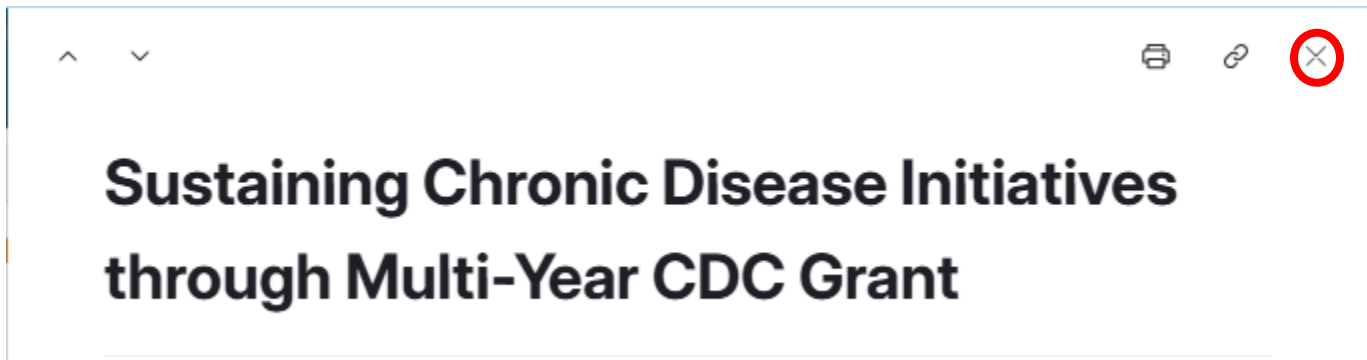

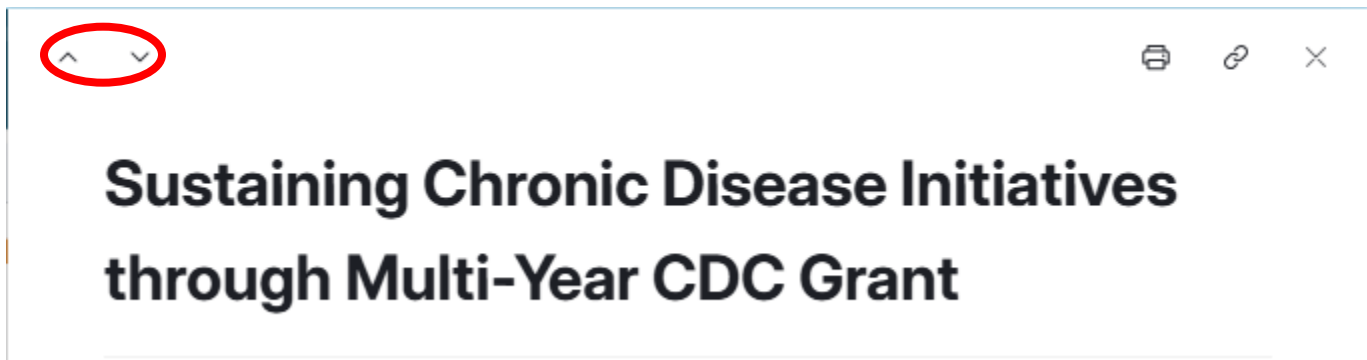

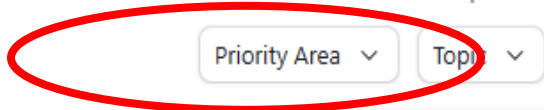

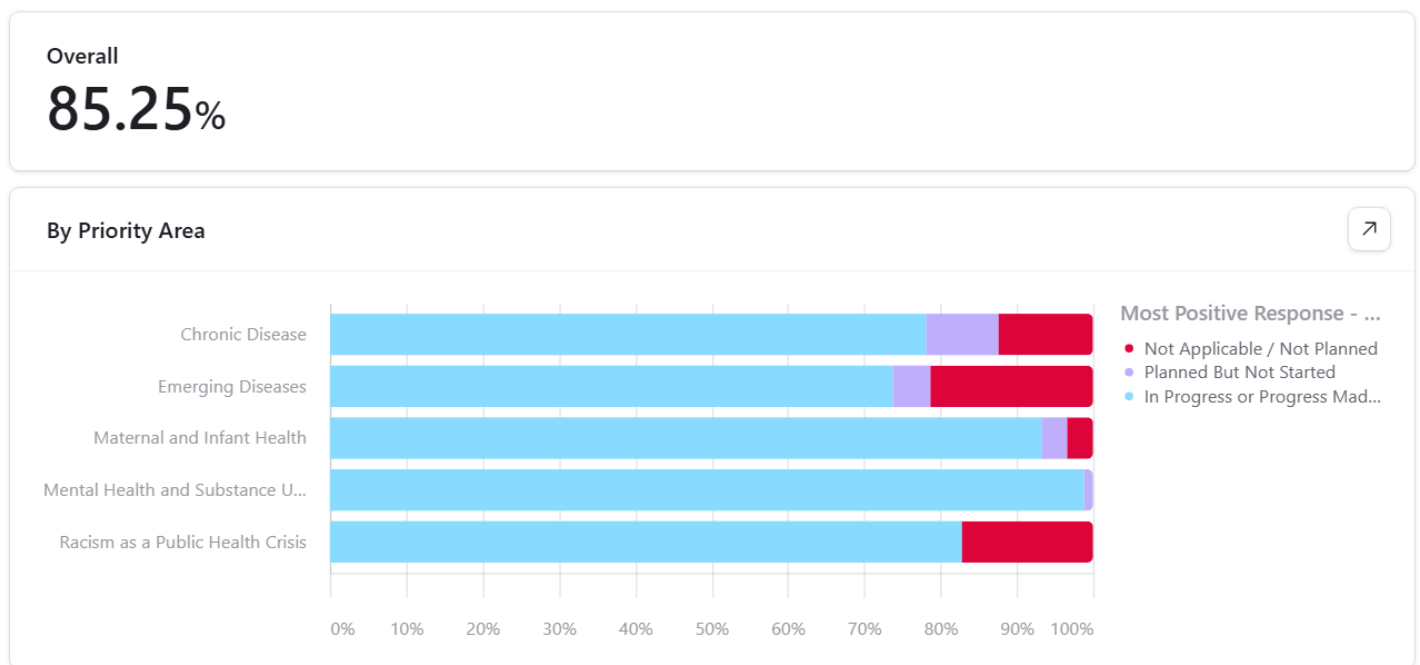

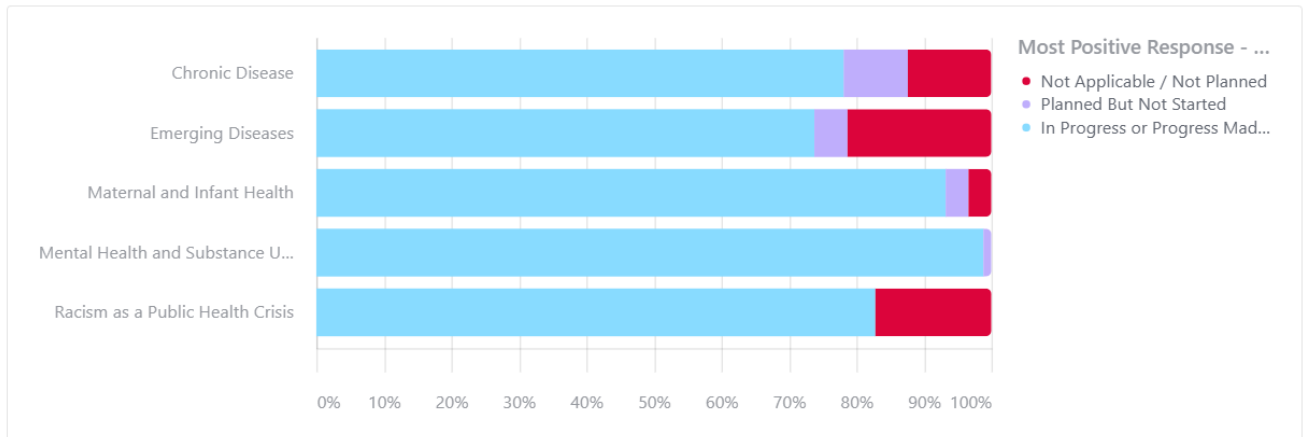
