Updates: Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH)

- 640 Rules: Expected to be with the governor's office by the end of summer- 640 is moving forward smoothly.
- Maternal Health Blueprint: in Collaboration with UIC and under the Birth Equity umbrella a contract has started and IDPH might be reaching out to get input from this team (PAC). More to come in the next meetings.

- New Maternal Health and **Birth Equity** Initiatives at South Side Birth Center: 4M Funding

This funding is directly coming from the legislative most recent legislative session and budget that was passed around birth equity, \$4 million will be available and the intention is for this funding to go towards communities that are having and noting adverse outcomes, in whatever way that might be in terms of geography, in terms of population and demographics. Neonatal Resuscitation Training- Discussion & VOTE

Statement: "Capability to provide neonatal resuscitation in the delivery room shall be satisfied by current completion of a Nationally recognized neonatal resuscitation by Medical, Nursing and Respiratory staff or a Rapid Response Team that includes a hands on component to demonstrate proficiency."
• The committee agrees to have this released as a memo and applied to the new 640 code.

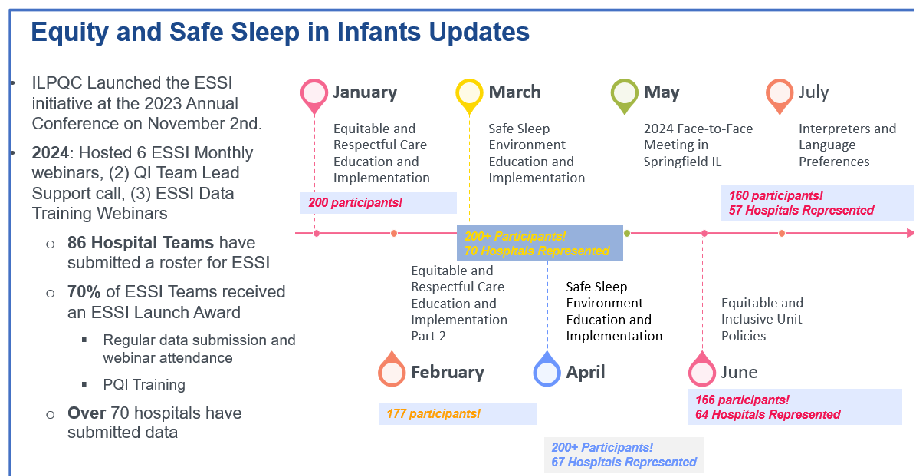

Illinois Perinatal Quality Collaborative (ILPQC) Update:

- PVB Sustainability
 - Teams are working to complete their Sustainability Plans and submit them to ILPQC and Perinatal Network Administrators; 29 teams submitted sustainability plans.
 - ILPQC hosted the third PVB Sustainability Webinar in July with 3 teams sharing their sustainability plans and 1 coaching team sharing their progress.
- Small Group Coaching
 - All coaching groups **help** their first small group coaching calls virtually in March and in-person at the Face-to-Face Meeting in Springfield, IL. The next Meetings are scheduled for September.
 - We have held **13 Key Players** meetings to engage hospital administration, OB and nursing leadership and PVB QI team at hospitals to increase buy-in for teams still working to achieve PVB goals. **6 more are scheduled** before Mid-September
