Re: NON-COMPLIANCE WITH COVID-19 REGULATIONS FROM THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH (77 Ill. Admin. Code 690.50).

On January 27, 2020, the United States Secretary of Health and Human Services declared that COVID-19, a respiratory illness spread by close contact through respiratory droplets, presents a public health emergency, and the World Health Organization characterized the COVID-19 outbreak as a pandemic on March 11, 2020.

Pursuant to the Department of Public Health Act, 20 ILCS 2305, the Department of Public Health Powers and Duties Law, 20 ILCS 2310, and the Communicable Disease Code, 77 Ill. Admin. Code 690, the Department of Public Health adopted emergency regulations, 77 Ill. Admin. Code 690.50, on August 7, 2020 to restrict and suppress COVID-19 as follows:

- Schools, including preschools, public and nonpublic schools that serve students in grades prekindergarten through grade 12, institutions of higher education, and vocational programs, and day cares, including day care centers, day care homes, and group day care homes licensed by the Department of Children & Family Services (DCFS) and day care centers that are exempt from licensure, shall require students, employees, and other individuals who are over age two and able to medically tolerate a face covering to cover their nose and mouth with a face covering when on premises. Schools and day cares may permit face coverings to be removed while eating or drinking, when individuals are outdoors and social distance is maintained, while playing a musical instrument if necessary, and, for staff, while using a face shield when necessary to allow for facial visualization during instruction and communication. Section 690.50(c)(3).
- Public and nonpublic schools serving pre-kindergarten through 12th grade students must limit the number of people in one space to fifty or fewer. Section 690.50(c)(4).
