II. Approval of Meeting Minutes

III. <u>Public Comments</u>

• Tamra Holland of Springfield described the isolating effects of nursing home visitation restrictions on mother and mother-in-law and requested compassionate care visits to be mandated.

IV. Old Business

- Brief COVID-19 Discussion
 - i. Ron Nunziato inquired about additional meetings to discuss concerns with testing rules presented at 10/29 special meeting. Laura Vaught said IDPH will file emergency testing rules not permanent rules for all LTC facilities licensed by IDPH.
 - ii. Betty Stewart provided information on status of Infection Control surveys in facilities – this week 146 facilities are on the survey list and the Department must survey within 3-5 days. Health Facility Survey Nurse's will be tested soon as protocol being developed.
 - iii. Annual and certification surveys are being resumed; some are being scheduled but must be cautious to have surveyors remain too long in the facilities.

V. New Business

- Past Non-Compliance and other items for this body to review and discuss (Ron Nunziato)
 - i. Surveyors do not clearly understand what "past noncompliance" means.
 - Process of substantiating a concern but results in no violation, i.e., something happened- but by no fault of the facility. Many other States use both of these and IL does not use (often) or it appears surveyors understand.
 - iii. Would also like to get re-visits on the agenda to discuss timeliness of revisits based on the CMS change to 14 days of compliance or Stop Payment is result. Often when a revisit is necessary and IDPH does not come in timely- complaints often come in and the complaint is counted as the revisit and then you are out of compliance based on this new CMS change. Requested an in-service with providers and DPH about definition and how it is applied. Michelle provided some explanation.
