What is Hepatitis A?


Highly contagious liver disease caused by a virus

Spread from person to person and can last weeks to months

Sharing needles or other drug **Drinking and** equipment Sexual eating contact contaminated with an food infected Sharing partner personal items Not washing your hands

If you feel that you are at risk for hepatitis A and you are experiencing any of these symptoms, seek medical treatment immediately!

How Can I Prevent it?

Get two shots of hepatitis A vaccine

Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water

Do not share needles

Do not share eating utensils

Do not share personal items
