HIV Disease Diagnoses, by Illinois Community Planning Region, 2006-2015

While, more than 63,000 people in Illinois have been diagnosed with HIV, diagnoses in Illinois are **down 28%** since 2006. In 2015, there were 1,539 new cases –the lowest number of annual new cases reported in nearly 30 years*.
