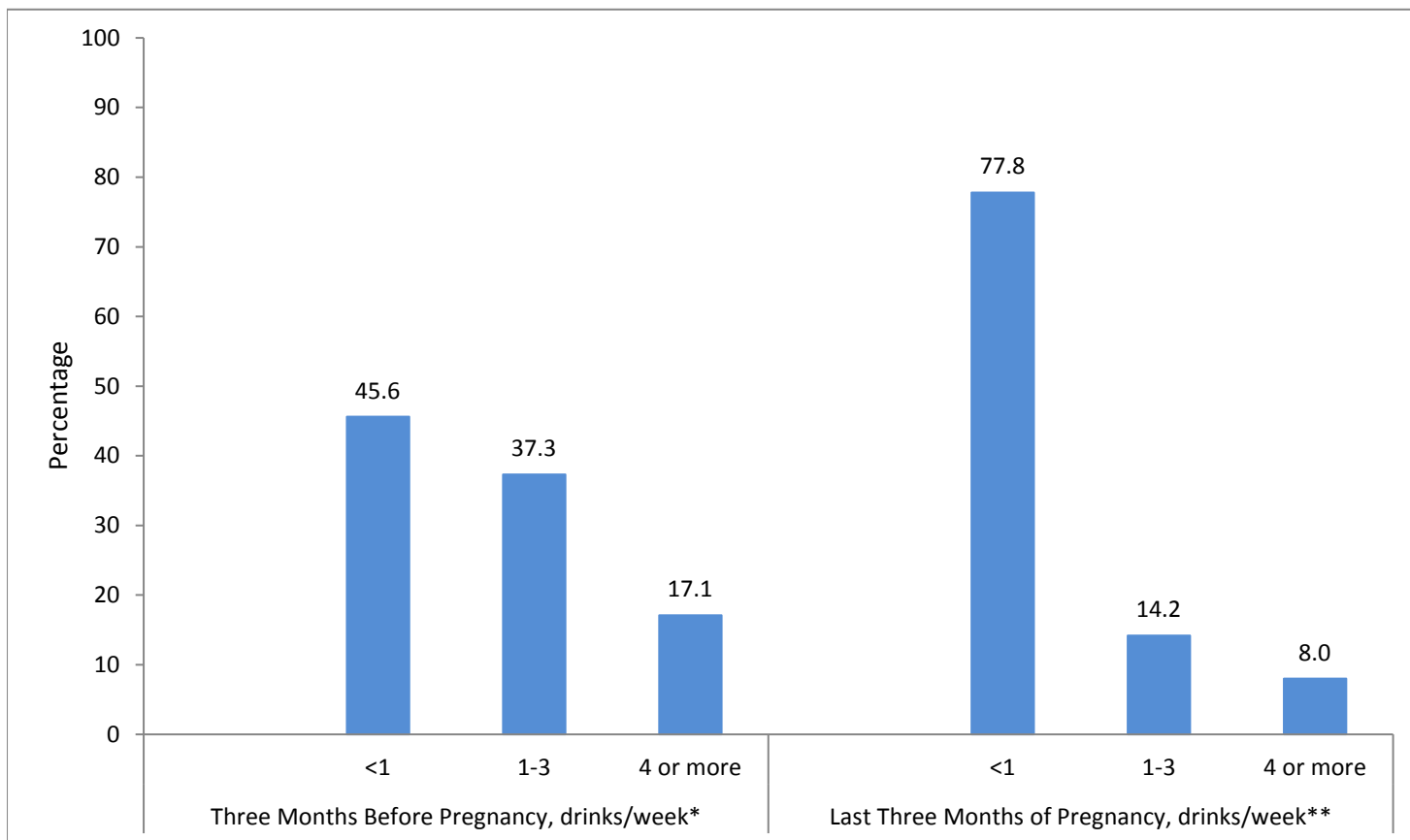


Alcohol Consumption
