Prospective Vendor Questions

Question In our review, we flagged the following mandatory element: Vendor must have existing mobile service delivery vehicles throughout the State of Illinois and should indicate in the response how many are available for deployment and their locations. The State will consider vendors with subcontract(s) to ensure statewide capacity.

While the prospective vendor does not currently have mobile service delivery vehicles in the State of Illinois, we have successfully deployed mobile vans in other state and country programs supporting both COVID-19 testing and vaccination programs.

Before proceeding with our response submission, I wanted to clarify with you how rigid this requirement will be for the State of Illinois when it comes to assessing our response? If we can demonstrate successful deployment of this model in other states with references, would this suffice for the mandatory element above?

Answer – The Vendor will need to demonstrate that they have the capability to provide vaccination services throughout the state.
