Oral Health Among Pregnant Women in Illinois

DID YOU KNOW?

Having periodontal disease while pregnant can increase the risk of premature birth and low birth weight.1 Approximately 40% of pregnant women have some form of periodontal disease

RISK FACTORS FOR Periodontal disease

- Not brushing or flossing regularly
- Not receiving dental cleaning regularly
- P
- Drinking sugar sweetened beverages
- Tobacco use



PREVENTING PERIODONTAL DISEASE

- Brushing your teeth twice a day and flossing
- Receiving a cleaning and examination every 6 months
- Limiting sugar sweetened beverages
- Avoid using tobacco and vaping products


