#### 1. IDPH Update

The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) staff was on hand to talk about upcoming combined meetings: 1) meeting with level I/II LOC WG regarding AWHONN Staffing guidelines and; 2) shared meeting with several LOC WG and the hospital facilities designation subcommittee of the PAC.

#### 2. Level III Requirements

- There was agreement that a "back-up" neonatologist should be available within 30 minutes in case of an unexpected emergency (e.g. urgent health condition for the on-call neonatologist)

#### Surgical Guidelines

- Discussion on the upcoming meeting and questions to ask during the AWHONN staffing meeting in January
- Discussed the surgical resources draft guidelines document that was sent to the committee members.
- Public Comment: Note that travel times for the ~50 miles in Chicagoland is much different than the rest of Illinois.
- Discussion on if the group would want to add the surgical resource guidelines during the rewrite? Should it be amended?
  - To amend the language on births happening at children's centers

- Proposal to change the language for Section 2.C.i.3 to identify a group of O.R. nurses who will consistently participate in pediatric and neonatal surgeries
- Public Comment: Number of required cases for surgical experience is not in the language
- Recommended having an identified team who will receive extra training and demonstrate additional competencies:
  - Recommended that pediatric radiology use the same language of: "Identify a group who will gain the proper competencies"
