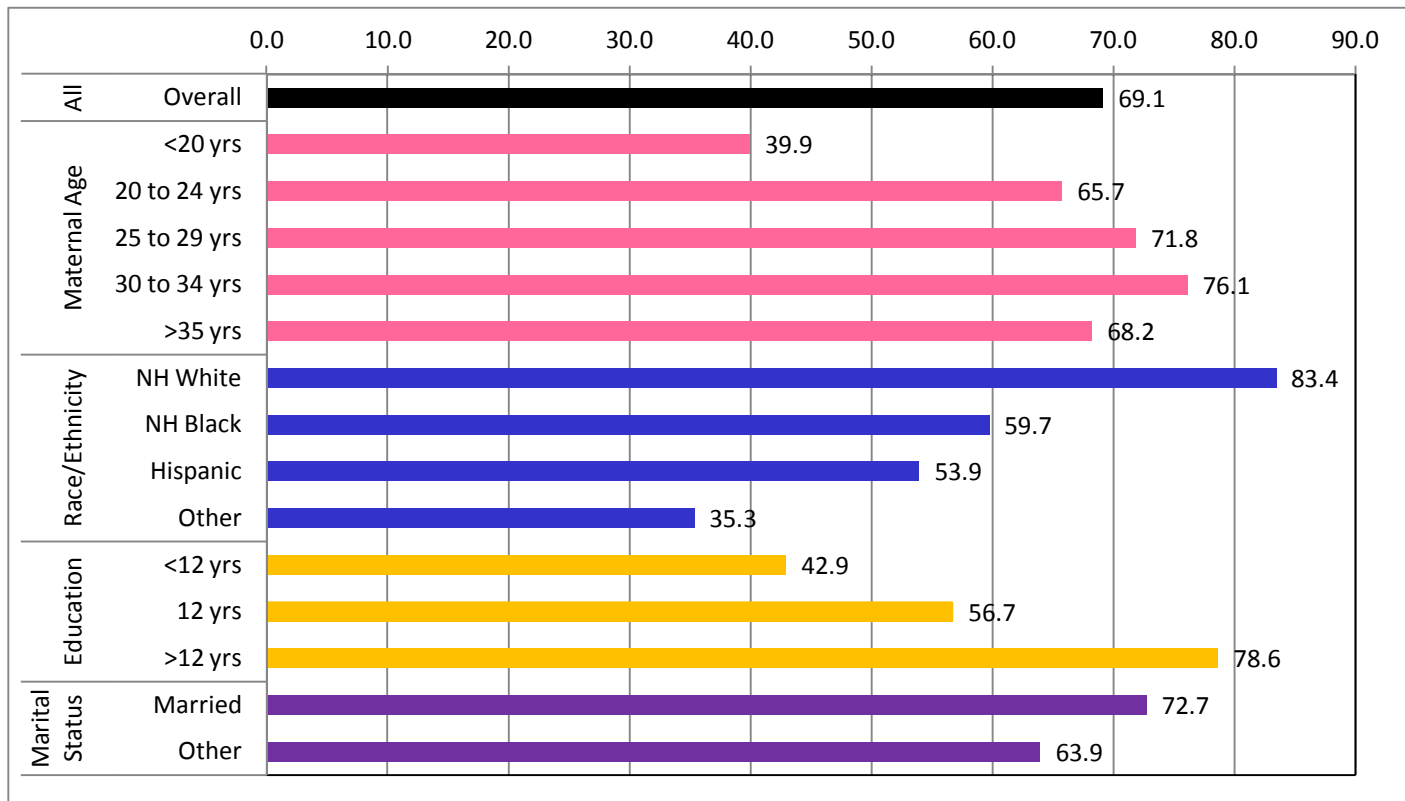


Alcohol Consumption
