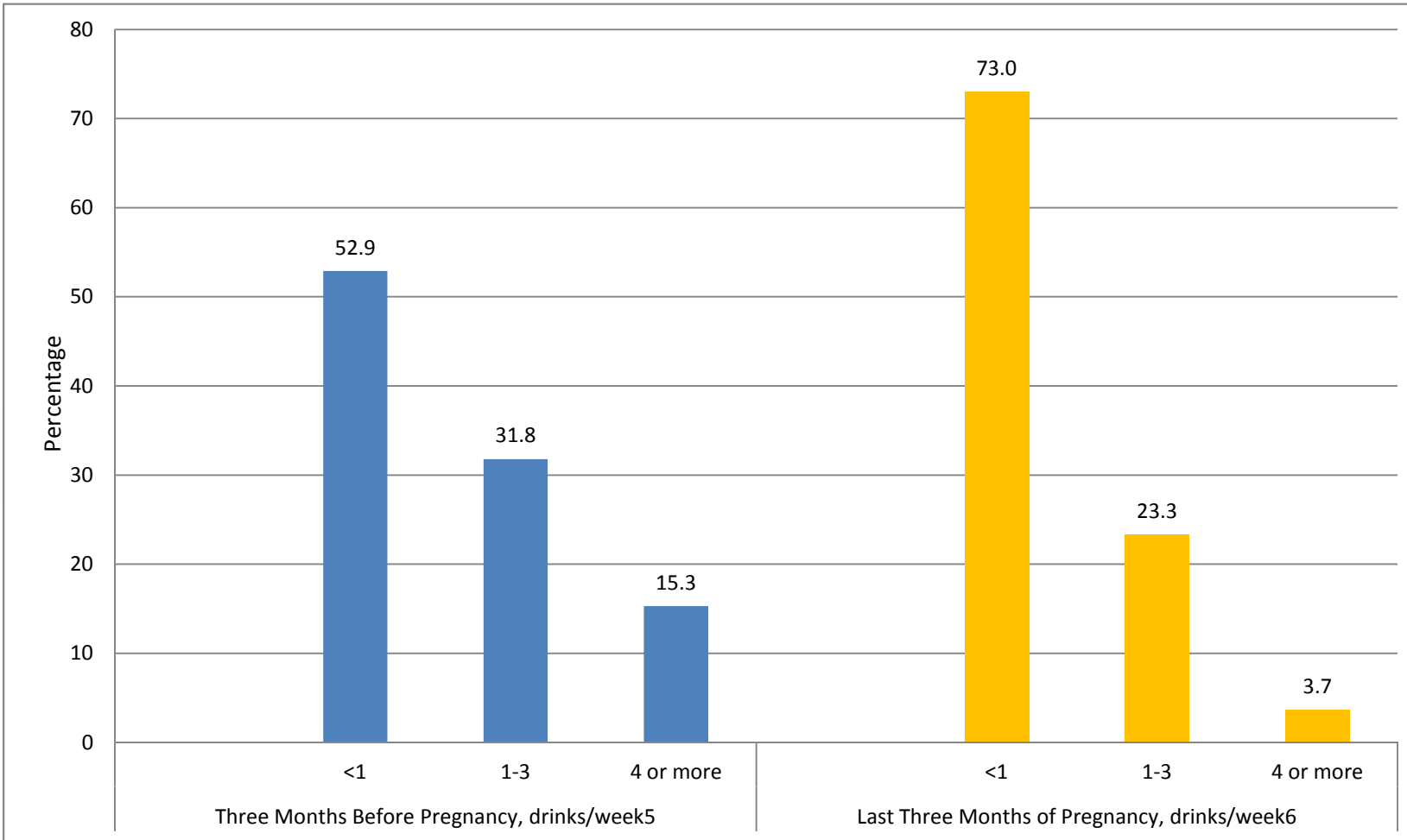


Alcohol Consumption
