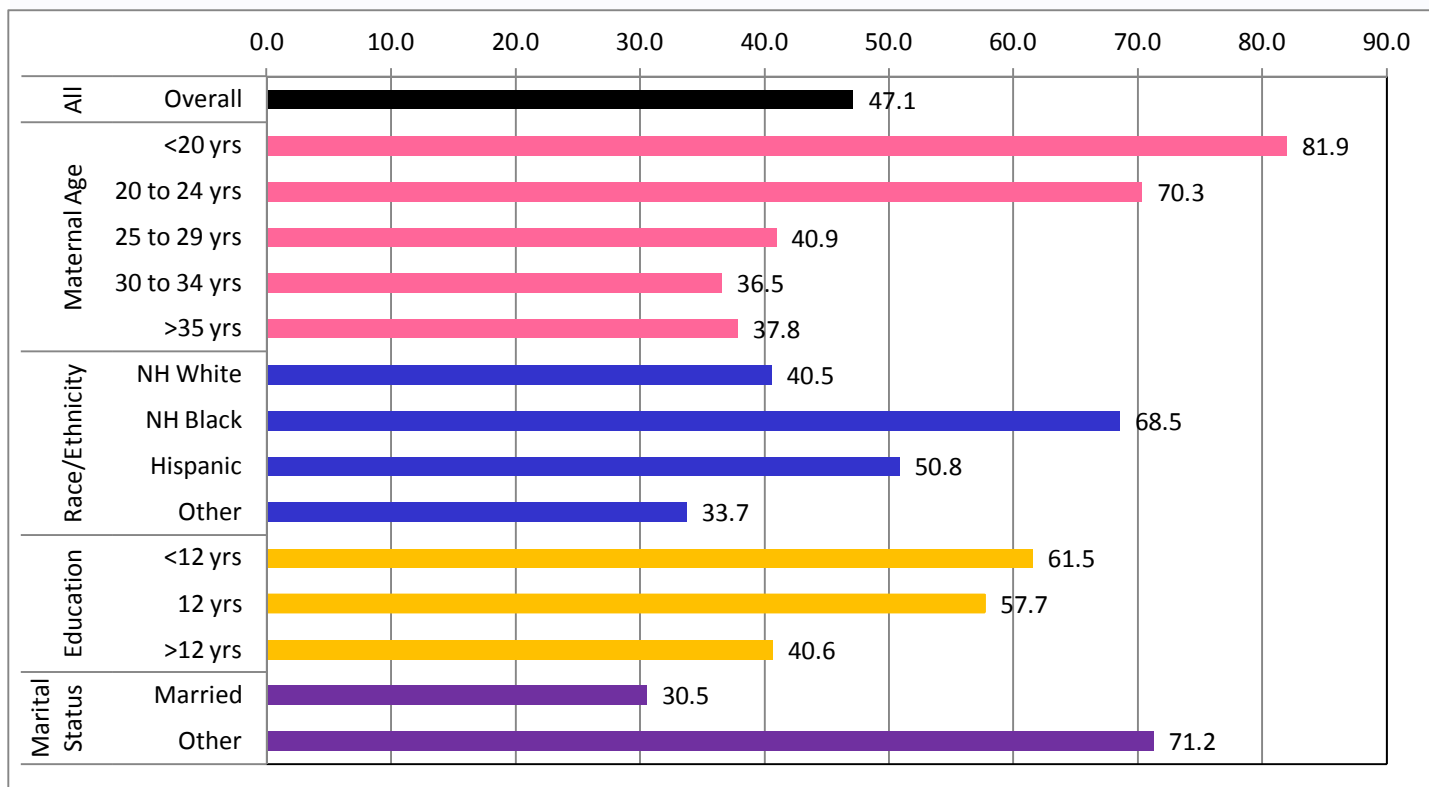


Pregnancy Intention

¹Survey Question 12: Thinking back to just before you got pregnant with your new baby, how did you feel about becoming pregnant? A. I want to be pregnant later; B. I wanted to be pregnant sooner; C. I want to be pregnant then; D. I didn't what to be pregnant then or at any time in the future; E. I wasn't sure what I wanted. Responses B and C were grouped as "Intended Pregnancy"; Responses A, D, and E were grouped as "Unintended Pregnancy".
